



# 2010 LORAS COLLEGE SUMMER SOCCER LEAGUE

Hosted by the Loras College Men's and Women's Soccer Teams  
Rock Bowl Stadium – Loras College – Dubuque, Iowa

**FORMAT:** Games will be 8 v 8 (7 and a goalkeeper); **10-game regular season and playoffs at end of season, based on regular season final standings.**

**DIVISIONS:** There will be men's open division, high school boys' and girls' divisions and we will attempt to have an over-30 division. If not enough interest in over 30, these teams will be asked to play in open. High school divisions will not begin until high school State tournaments are completed. High school divisions will play twice per week. We will offer a one-day clinic to participants in the high school division as part of the high school League.

**FACILITY:** All games will be played in the Rock Bowl Stadium, Loras College. **Field size: 70 yds. x 50 yds.**

**COST:** \$599 per team, with a maximum roster of 14 – it is under \$45 per player for the season! To add a player to the roster after first game is an additional \$50. See rules about substitute players who can be used on a game-to-game basis.

**DEADLINE:** Entries will be accepted on a first-come/first-serve basis. Entries due May 15. June 1 deadline for high school divisions.

**SCHEDULE:** Teams will play at least one game per week with games taking place mostly on weeknights. Weeknight game times will be at 6:00 p.m., 7:00 p.m., 8:00 p.m. or 9:00 p.m. with a few Fridays and Saturday morning games, if needed (check game dates). Possible game dates are: May 25, 27; June 1, 3, 8, 10, 15, 17, 25, 26; July 6, 7, 8, 9, 16, 17, 23, 24. Let us know if there is a particular game time or day you prefer or want to avoid (see registration form). We will do our best to accommodate requests, but cannot guarantee all requests will be met. Our priority is to have a fully scheduled League.

**JERSEYS:** Every team will be given numbered Loras Summer League T-shirt jerseys. No need to buy jerseys.

**RULES:**

The 2010 Loras College Summer Soccer League will follow all normal FIFA soccer rules and regulations with the exception of the following:

1. All games will be 50 minutes in length, with two 25-minute halves and a 5-minute halftime. Regular season games can end in a tie. Games are 8 v 8 (7 and a goal keeper).
2. Any ball that crosses over either sideline will be put into play with an indirect kick. **No throw ins. All out of bounds plays result in an indirect kick.**
3. All fouls shall result in a direct free kick from the spot of the infraction, unless the foul occurs in the penalty area. In this case, the restart shall be a penalty kick taken from the designated penalty spot.
4. Offenses that merit a player being sent off will result in that player being removed from the game (without replacement) for the duration of that game (this includes two yellow cards). The offending player will not be allowed to play in the next game.
5. Substitutions will be unlimited and “on the fly”.
6. Teams will be limited to a 14-person roster. Fill in players will be allowed at a cost of \$5 for each fill-in player used. Fill-in players must be rostered League players from another team in the League. Maximum of three fill-ins per game.

The League Commissioner reserves the right to modify, amend and/or delete these League rules at any time. No protests are allowed – the game official’s ruling is final!!!



Champps is the official post game and World Cup Headquarters of the League. Champps has agreed to not only sponsor our League, but to offer 10% off to every League member when they visit Champps. We look forward to having a place where the League can go after games to talk soccer and enjoy the soccer community of Dubuque. Also, Champps has agreed to play all 2010 World Cup games live this summer for anyone interested in watching as a soccer community and will also show them on tape-delay in the evenings after League games (for those who can’t watch during the day).

I do hereby fully release and discharge Loras College and its directors, officers, trustees, agents, servants, and employees from any and all claims from injuries, including death, damage, or loss which my child/ward or I may have or which may accrue to me on account of my child/ward or my participation.
