The College Prep Weekend is designed to expose campers to training and competition that they will find at the college level. Coach Rothert and his staff of Loras coaches, assisted by current Duhawk soccer players, will run training sessions just like those that have helped the Loras men's and women's programs become two of the nation's elite college soccer programs. Campers will also be provided plenty of opportunities to compete each day so they can demonstrate what they have learned.

The camp is open to soccer players 15 years of age or older, but is primarily intended for those entering their junior and senior year of high school. The camp will take place at Loras, include an overnight stay and meals will be provided by Loras' dining service. Goalkeepers will receive specialized training. Each camp has a limited number of openings, so get your registration in early. Boys' and girls' camps will be separate, but simultaneous.

HOUSING AND MEALS

REGISTRATION

To register for the camp, fill out the Registration form and the Waiver and Release form (on back) and return to the address indicated along with a check for \$110 payable to *Loras Soccer Camp*. Players who wish to room together on a team should indicate their roommate preference on the registration form. After registering for the camp, you will receive a confirmation email including directions to where registration will be the first day of the camp.

Check in is from 11:00 a.m.-12:00 noon on Friday with lunch at 12:00 noon. Camp will end at approximately 2:00 p.m. on Saturday.

CAMP DIRECTOR DAN ROTHERT



Coach Dan Rothert has developed nationally recognized men's and women's soccer programs during his career at Loras. In his 12th year, his teams have won 10 IIAC Conference titles, advanced to the NCAA Tournament 12 times and has been named Conference Coach of the Year 8 times and regional Coach of the Year twice. Rothert's women have advanced to the NCAA tournament 7 times, including one "Sweet 16" finish and finished 2009 12-5-4, ranked in the regional top 10 all season long. His men have advanced to two NCAA "Sweet 16's" and two NCAA Final Fours and have finished the last 3 years ranked in the national top 10 with 20+ wins in each of the last 3 years. Coach Rothert holds the highest attainable coaching licenses in the USA, including a USSF "A" License and the US Youth Soccer National Youth License and he holds undergraduate and graduate degrees in Physical Education from Loras College.

Loras assistant coaches and current soccer student-athletes and other college coaches will assist Coach Rothert with the camp.
